The #PutChildrenFirst campaign by Alder Hey Children's Charity has launched its new #IgniteTheSparks film.

The film shows three local young people - Jai, Sophia and Havin – who all have people talent and potential. They represent every child who should have unlimited possibilities but may be at risk due to unfairness, poverty and inequality.

Supported by new You Gov polling which found just 12% of Brits think children will reach their full potential, Jai, Sophia and Havin were brought together to demonstrate what could be lost if the Government doesn't put children first.
